- 6. Collect and dispose of a piece of litter—take a picture
- 7. A flying insect
- 8. A blooming flower on a tree
- 9. A new leaf
- 10.A bee (any type of bee is good)
- 11. Animal tracks (any animal that is not a human)
- 12.A seed dispersed by wind

Bonus Points

- 1. Video of frogs calling at night
- 2. Picture of a fish in a pond, spring, lake or river
- Picture of an animal that eats mosquitos (dragonfly, bat, tree swallow)
